#### ITEM 5 - CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

## **5.1** Additional Allocations

I wish to advise the members of the following additional allocations from the Department of Health and Children:

- €1.337m (€0.140m once off) funding in respect of the provision of various services to people with intellectual disability and autism
- **40.354m** revenue funding in respect of costs arising from the appointment of a temporary consultant in emergency medicine
- €0.100m once off grant to the Holy Family School Parents Association to assist with the costs associated with equipping a multi-sensory room for children attending the school in Cootehill
- **40.017m** on a once off basis to the Irish Advocacy Network in 2003

### **Capital Funding**

- €1.013m Capital Funding has been approved in respect of ICT (Information and Communication Technology) Projects
- €0.250m capital grant towards the upgrade of the main electrical switchboard and ESB supply at Monaghan General Hospital
- **©0.075m** once off capital grant towards Ballivor Community Council, Co. Meath
- **40.030m** once off capital grant towards Kilnaleck Community Co-op Society Ltd., Co. Cavan

# 5.2 Daffodil Day Funded Grant

I wish to inform you that the Board has received funding amounting to €34,750 from the Irish Cancer Society for the quarter commencing 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2003. These funds will be used towards palliative care services and I would like to thank the Irish Cancer Society for their continued contribution of funds.

#### 5.3 Appointments

Dr. Rosemary Curran, Consultant Microbiologist took up duty in the Cavan Monaghan Hospital Group on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003.

Dr. Richard Lynch commenced duty as a temporary Consultant in Emergency Medicine in the Cavan Monaghan Hospital Group on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003.

## **5.4** Inspector of Mental Health Services

#### 5.5 Health Promotion

The NEHB won a 'best poster presentation award' at the World Conference on Tobacco Control in August 2003. The poster presentation, which is part of the awareness campaign to inform school-aged children about the dangers of smoking, was judged on the criteria of innovation, cost and effectiveness.

## 5.6 Cardiovascular Strategy

In July 2003, Primary Care Services introduced a structured approach to Type II Diabetes Care in the region. This initiative is based on recommendations included in the Government's Cardiovascular Health Strategy - *Building Healthier Hearts*. Phase I of this pilot project will involve 13 General Practitioner Training Practices and is targeted at a cohort of patients with Type II Diabetes who meet certain criteria.

#### 5.7 Men's Health

The report of the Men's Health Consultation Day held in November 2002 was officially launched on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2003, at the inaugural meeting of the Men's Health Consultative Group. It is intended that this multi-agency group will produce a draft action plan for men's health by the end of 2003.

## 5.8 Slane Concert 2003

The Annual Slane Concert was held on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> August in the grounds of Slane Castle. The Board provided an on-site accident and emergency service for an attendance of approximately 80,000 people. A total of 194 casualties were treated in the on-site medical centre, an increase of 62% on the 2002 figures. 25 casualties were transferred to the receiving hospitals in Navan and Drogheda.
