#### Introduction

- This survey questionnaire was included on Lansdowne Omnibus survey of 1,180 adults aged 15+
- Fieldwork took place between September 26th and October 6th, 2000 at 60 sampling points nationally

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#### Introduction

- The questionnaire was designed by Drury Research with input from the DHF and other interested parties
- Key learning from a previous phase of qualitative research in July 2000 were also considered and incorporated into the questionnaire design
- Where appropriate reference is made to this phase of the research in this presentation.



### Main Findings

Survey Highlights







#### Fluoride in Water

- When it comes to people's general concerns, fluoride in water is not a high level concern
  - less than a quarter or 23% overall are very concerned, a further 22% fairly concerned
- However, over half of those surveyed (50%) were very concerned about water pollution
- If water fluoridation were to be presented in the light of a water pollutant, then it could Drury Research potentially be a much higher level concern.












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
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#### Care of the Environment

- Married females (56%) are more inclined to be very concerned about caring for the environment
  - higher proportions of 35-49 (53%) and 50-64 (55%) year olds also
  - higher social classes and those with children in the household
  - regionally, those in Connaught/Ulster (65%) are very concerned







#### Care of the Environment

- There is also a high correlation between concern for the care of the environment and concern about the level of fluoride in water
- Two thirds (66%) of those who are concerned about the level of fluoride in water are concerned about the environment
- This suggests, as with the qualitative research, that many people see water fluoridation as an environmental issue



#### Water Pollution & Litter

- Water pollution as an issue was of greater concern to;
  - those in Connaught/Ulster (69%)
  - those in rural areas generally (61%)
  - those generally concerned about fluoride in water (66%)
- Those most concerned about litter are;
  - those in Connaught/Ulster (63%)
  - rural dwellers generally (57%)
  - those concerned about fluoride in water (63%)






#### Fluoride in Water

- Overall 35-64 year olds are most concerned
  - 27% of the 35-49 age group
  - 26% of 50-64 age group
- Higher income groups, rural dwellers and farmers also appeared more concerned than the average
  - 27% of ABC1s
  - 27% of farmers
  - 26% of those in Leinster outside Dublin
  - 29% of those in Connaught/Ulster
  - 32% of rural dwellers generally







#### Fluoride in Water


- Almost a third of those (29%) of those whose domestic water contains fluoride are very concerned
- Concern is slightly higher for;
  - those who sometimes use fluoride toothpaste (29%)very concerned
  - those who have heard of the DHF 32%
- Overall, the Euro (27%), the Internet (24%) and fluoride in water (24%) had the highest ambivalence scores.

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

Q2 Have you ever heard of the substance fluoride?











### **Knowledge of Fluoride**

- 86% have heard of fluoride
- 14% have not
- 90% of 25-34 year olds
- 93% of ABC1s
- 90% of those with children v 84% of those without
- Rest of Leinster 91% aware of fluoride
- 88% rural dwellers generally
- 95% of those whose domestic water contains fluoride
- 93% of those who always use fluoride toothpaste
- 89% of those who sometimes use fluoride toothpaste
- Prury Research 95% of those who have heard of the DHF






Q3 Have you seen or heard anything recently, that is, in the past 12 months, about fluoride in water?

## Have you seen/heard anything in the past 12 months about fluoride in water?

- Married men & women 50% respectively have higher knowledge of recent coverage
- 35-49 year olds (50%)
- 50-64 year olds (48%)
- ABC1 49%
- Those with kids in the household 49%
- Connaught/Ulster 52%






## Have you seen/heard anything in the past 12 months about fluoride in water?

- 54% of those whose domestic water contains fluoride
- 53% of those who are very/fairly concerned about fluoride
- 50% of those who always use a fluoride toothpaste
- 67% of those who have heard of the DHF

# Whether Domestic Water Contains Fluoride

- 63% in Dublin claim their water contains fluoride
- 51% in Rest of Leinster
- 49% in Munster
- 48% in Connaught
- 67% of ABC1s
- 57% of those with kids



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# Whether Domestic Water Contains Fluoride


• 62% of those who are very/fairly concerned about the level of fluoride in water claim that their domestic water contains fluoride

• 68% of those aware of the DHF say that their domestic supply has fluoride





Q6 To the best of your knowledge, what is the purpose of adding fluoride to drinking water






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- The purpose of fluoride in water is confused between dental health and water purification
- This is consistent with the qualitative research findings
- However, a more direct correlation is made between fluoride in toothpaste and dental health
- However, there are still one in five almost who do not understand its purpose.



Q7 What do you think is the purpose of adding fluoride to toothpaste?







- In Dublin, 56% say it's to prevent tooth decay
- 46% of urban dwellers generally understand fluoride is there to prevent tooth decay
- Of those who are very/fairly concerned about the level of fluoride, as many as 42% say to prevent tooth decay, as 41% who say to purify the water
- More people, 54%, whose domestic supply contains fluoride understand that it's to prevent tooth decay v 37% whose water doesn't contain fluoride





- Of those who always use fluoride toothpaste, 47% understand that it's to prevent tooth decay
- 53% of ABC1s understand fluoride's purpose in water v 39% of C2DEs
- 51% of those who had heard of the DHF v 42% who haven't understood the purpose of fluoride in water







- By the time the age reaches 50-64 almost 1/3 (32%) have some dentures and over 1 in five (28%) have full dentures.
- Over 9 in 10 of 15-24 year olds have all their own teeth






Q9 How often do you actually brush your teeth?








Q10 Do you use fluoride toothpaste?







# Dental Health by Frequency of Toothbrushing




Q13 What would you suggest as the best ways to help prevent tooth decay?








# Dental Health by Usage of Fluoride Toothpaste








# Frequency of Toothbrushing by Sex & Age

# Frequency of Toothbrushing by Class

- Farmers are less frequent toothbrushers
- ABC1 being most frequent






- Those who always use a fluoride toothpaste (82%) brush their teeth more often, i.e. twice a day or more, as do those who are aware of the DHF (79%)
- There is no correlation between usage of fluoride toothpaste and those who are concerned about the levels of fluoride in water
  - indicating that the connection is not between the substance in water and toothpaste
  - consistent with the qualitative research findings



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
Q11 Which picture is closest to the amount of toothpaste you normally use when you are brushing your teeth?

# **Usage of Toothpaste**


- Appears that all ages, sex, social classes are using too much toothpaste
- No differences by groups or regions/class as to how best to prevent tooth decay
- 15-24 year olds (25%) & farmers (24%) are most likely to trust dentists



### Awareness of the DHF


- Awareness of the DHF low overall (25%), consistent with the findings in the focus groups
- It is highest in the following groups;
  - ABC1 social class (30%)
  - 35-49 year olds (34%)
  - Those with kids (30%)
  - Those concerned about fluoride in water (32%)
  - Rest of Leinster (32%)
  - Connaught/Ulster (32%)




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

- We can get too much fluoride nowadays, 51% generally, but 64% of those concerned about fluoride in water
- 89% of those concerned about fluoride feel the public should be consulted v 80% overall
- Need more info. 81% of those concerned v 71% generally
- 18% overall, but 27% of those who are concerned about fluoride believe it can lead to lead poisoning





- Cancer causing fluoride 16% overall, 22% of those concerned about fluoride
- Preference for fluoride free water 44% overall v 53% for those concerned about fluoride in water
- 64% of those concerned believe we can get too much fluoride nowadays v 51% overall





- Overall, findings consistent with qualitative research
- There is now a robust body of data suggesting that people have higher level concerns other than fluoride in water on the surface





- There is an indication in the arguments against fluoridation, that the public is playing back the anti-campaign messages
- This is evident in the attitude statements also and the wish to be consulted and for more information that has been expressed in both this and the qualitative research





- In the absence of very strong opinion about water fluoridation there is potential for a persuasive campaign to be orchestrated
- Indications are that those who have concerns about fluoride in water play back the anti-campaign





- In the main the issue and information regarding fluoride in water is seen to be the remit of the Department of Health&Children
- However, there is an environmental dimension to this issue that has the potential to be emotive
- Water quality and purification is linked in the public mind to fluoridation.



- Awareness of the DHF is low, however, it appears best in households with children and amongst those who are concerned about fluoride in water
- Connaught/Ulster as a region appears to have higher proportions of those concerned about environmental issues generally and water fluoridation.





## Recommendations

- Educate people regarding fluoridation of water and its purpose
- Consider presenting a more balanced debate than what is currently in the public domain
- Consider the potential for negatives around the overall ingestion of fluoride via dental products in addition to water





### Recommendations

- Consider both the environmental and dental health perspectives especially as the issue of water purity is an emotive environmental one and a higher level concern generally that has the potential to be 'whipped up' by the anti-fluoridation campaign
- Consider schools for households with children as a route to transmitting key messages regarding fluoride.
