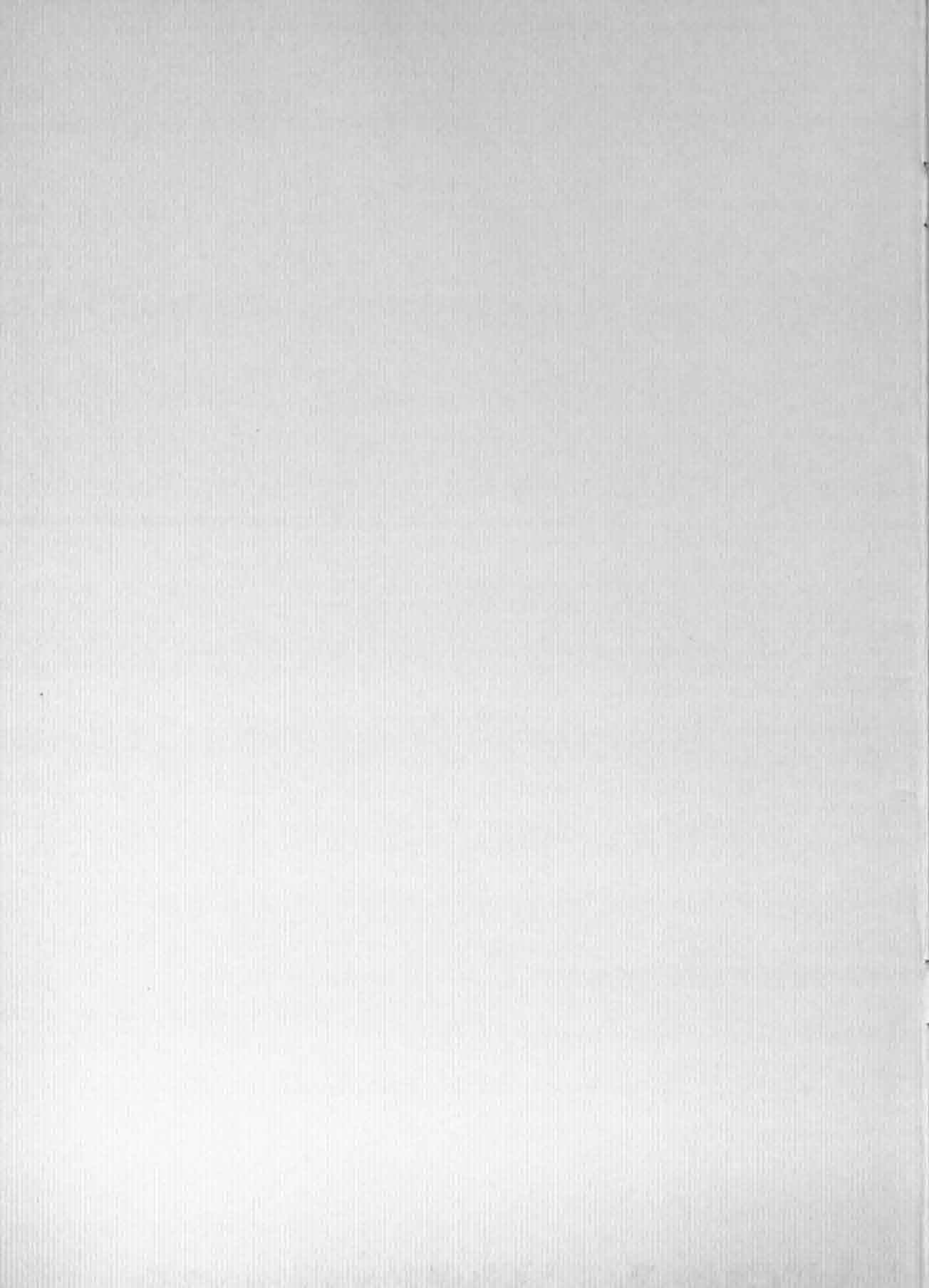

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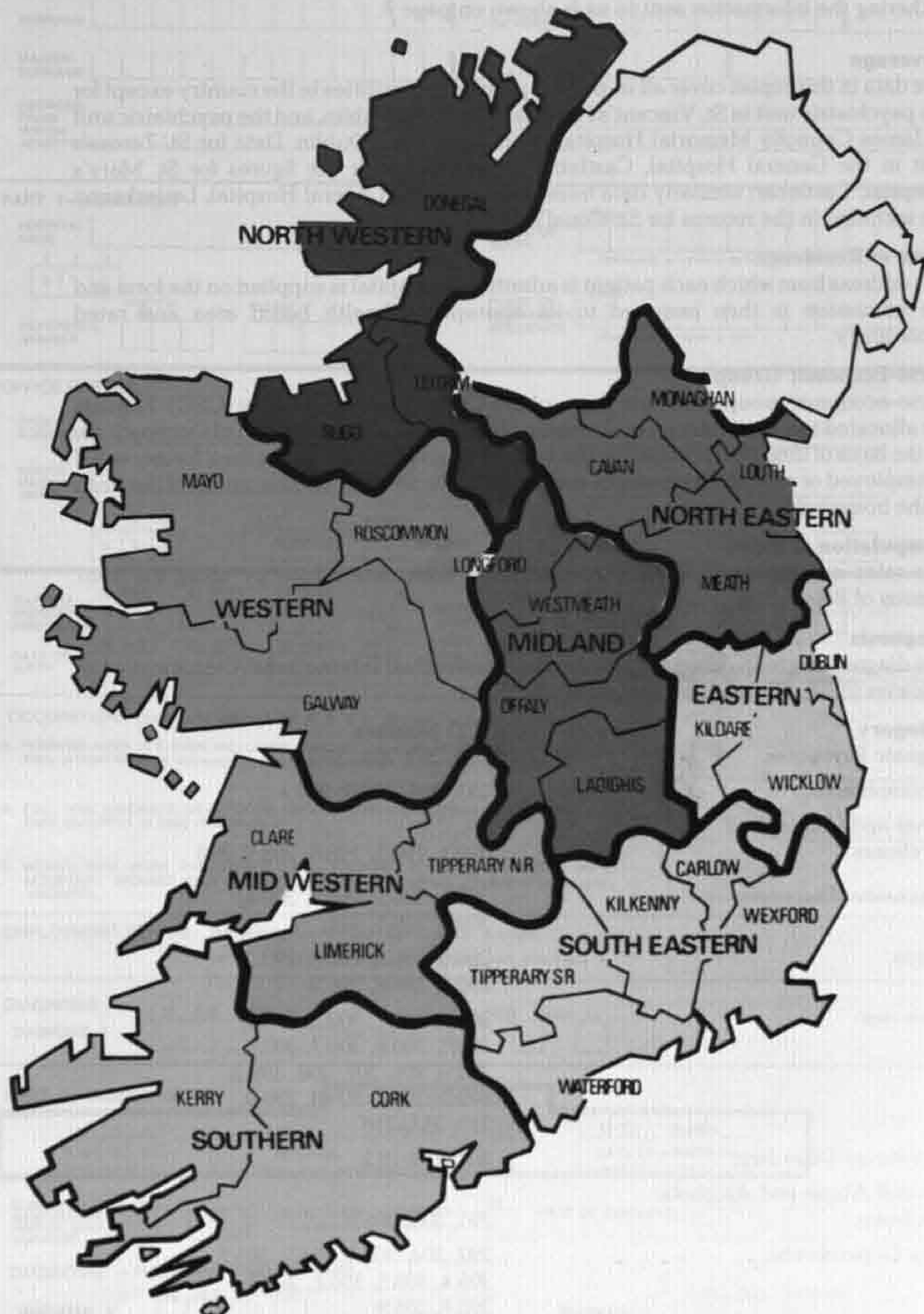

Introduction

We present this report in three sections, first for the entire country, second for health boards and thirdly for each hospital individually. Data presented here constitute that thought to be of general interest but more extensive information is available and can be obtained on request from the Health Research Board. The form used by hospitals for gathering the information sent to us is shown on page 7.

Coverage

The data in this report cover all in-patient psychiatric facilities in the country except for the psychiatric unit in St. Vincent's Hospital, Elm Park, Dublin, and the psychiatric unit in James Connolly Memorial Hospital, Blanchardstown, Dublin. Data for St. Teresa's unit in the General Hospital, Castlebar is included with the figures for St. Mary's Hospital, Castlebar; similarly data from the unit in the General Hospital, Letterkenny are included in the returns for St. Conal's, Letterkenny.

Place of Residence

The address from which each patient is admitted to hospital is supplied on the form and the admission is then assigned to its appropriate health board area and rated accordingly.

Socio-Economic Group

Socio-economic groups used are those of the Central Statistics Office (CSO). Patients are allocated to a particular group according to the CSO's Classification of Occupations, on the basis of their own occupation (including employment status) or their former one if unemployed or retired. Dependents are coded to the socio-economic group of the head of the household.

Computation of Rates

The rates accompanying numerical data have been determined by using the 1981 Census of Population.

Diagnosis

The diagnostic groups used are a grouping of individual International Classification of Diseases (ICD), 9th edition, categories as follows:

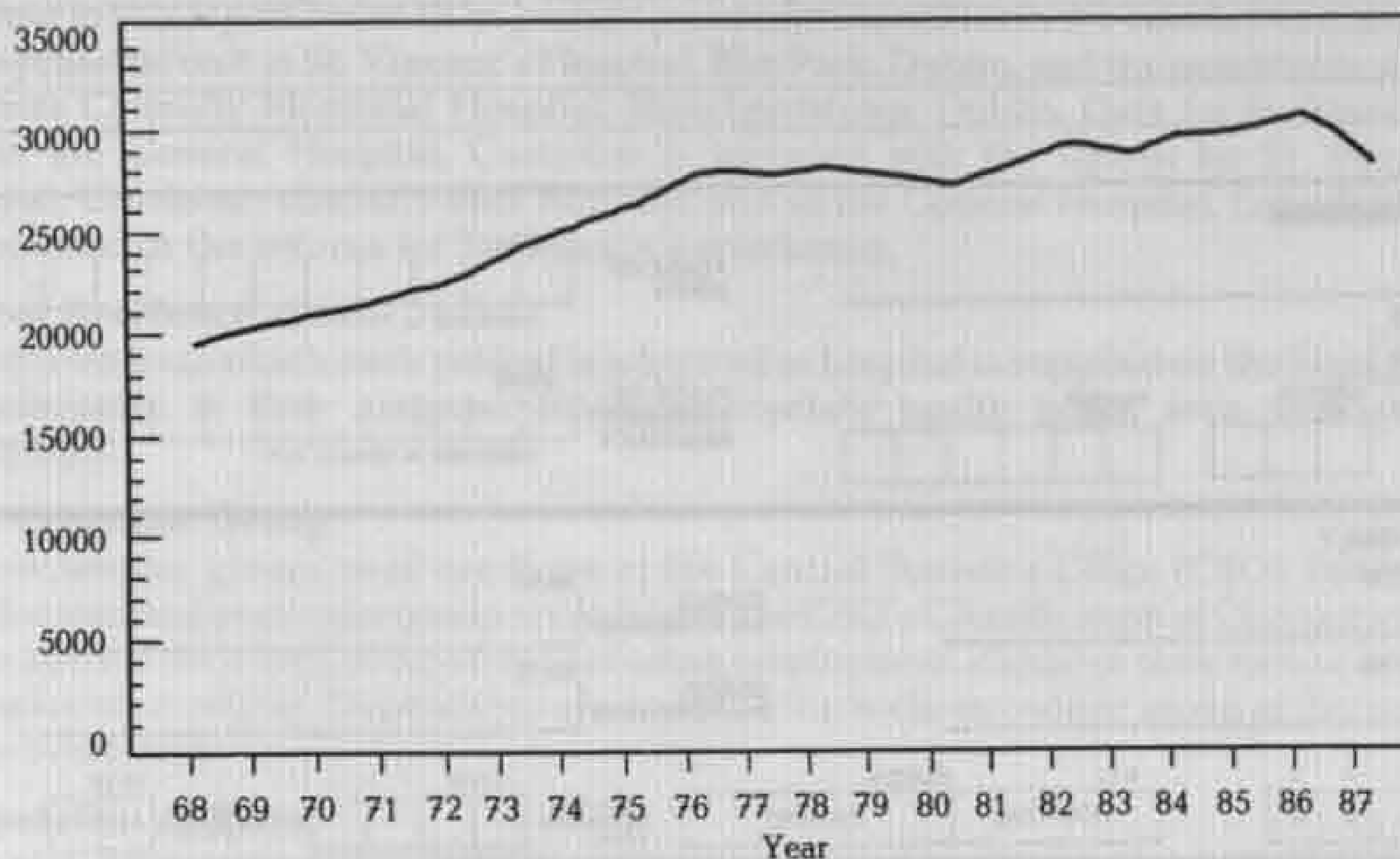

Commentary

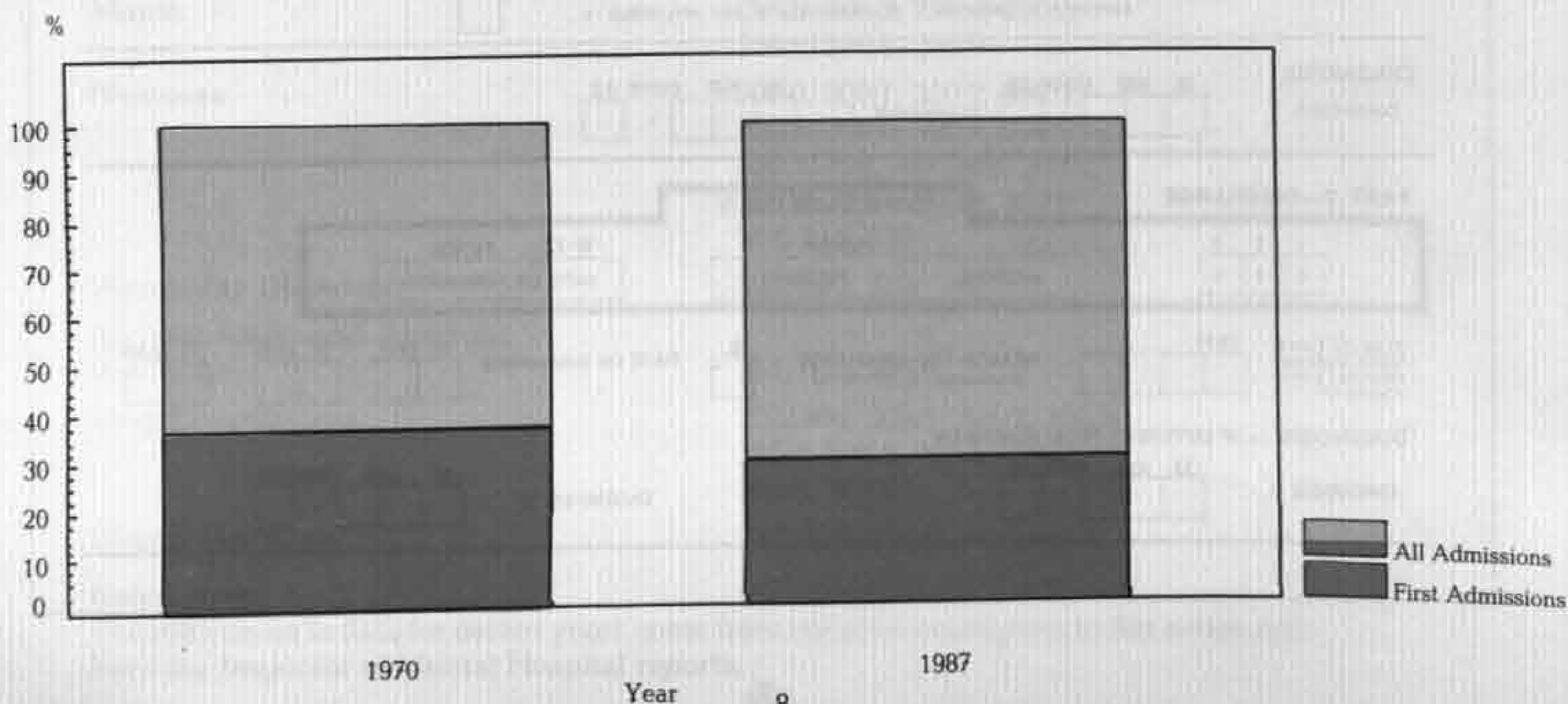
There were 27,856 admissions to Irish Psychiatric hospitals and units during 1987. This is the lowest figure recorded since 1980, when there were 27,098 admissions, and represents a substantial decline on the 1986 figure of 29,392 admissions. Figure 1 shows the trend in all admissions (that is, first and readmissions) to psychiatric hospitals and units for the last twenty years.

The steady rise in admissions during that time was occasionally interrupted by slight decreases as, for example, between 1978 and 1980, but the trend has been towards ever-increasing numbers. We must await the 1988 and 1989 figures before we know whether the 1987 figure represents another fluctuation in the upward trend. Given the development of community psychiatric services, we would expect some reduction in the use of psychiatric hospitals. However, as we pointed out in the 1986 report, readmissions and not first admissions have accounted for the increases in numbers since 1976. There are many illnesses which still require occasional, albeit short, hospital stays although the major part of psychiatric treatment can be provided through community services.

All and First Admissions. Percentages.

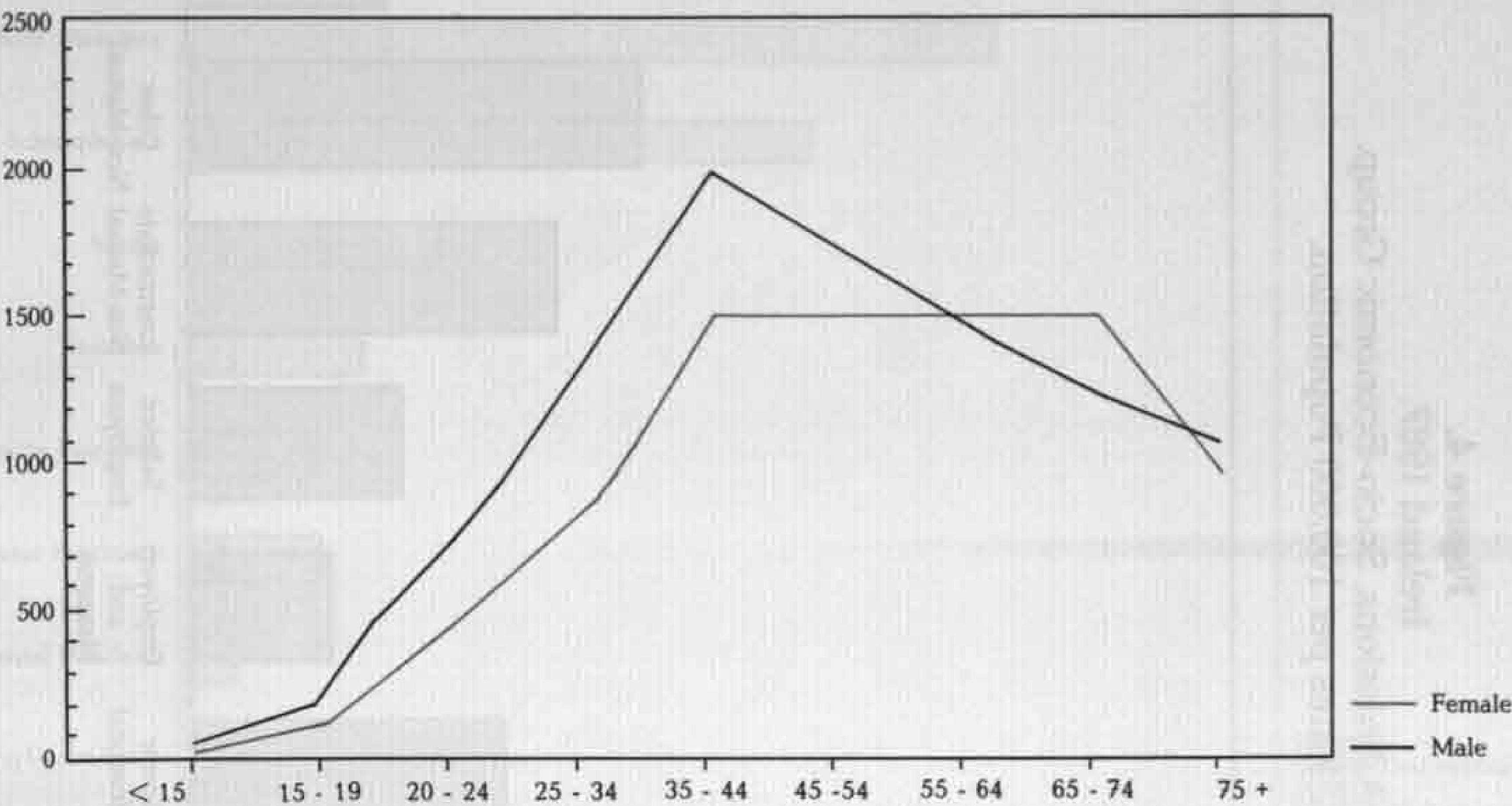


The decline in first admissions to psychiatric hospitals and units can be seen in Figure 2. The number of first admissions in 1987 was 7,934 and constituted 29% of all admissions. This was the lowest number recorded since 1970, when the figure was 7,696. The 1970 figure constituted 39% of all admissions for that year.

Age, Sex and Marital Status

The numbers of first and all admissions for men continue to outnumber those for women. This means that not only are men more likely than women to be admitted to a psychiatric hospital in the first instance, but that, following discharge, they are more likely to be readmitted. The male admission rate exceeds the female rate for every age-group up to 55 years and over. The difference between the sexes is particularly marked in the 35 to 44 year age-group, Figure 3.

All Admissions. Male and Female Rates for each Age-Group.



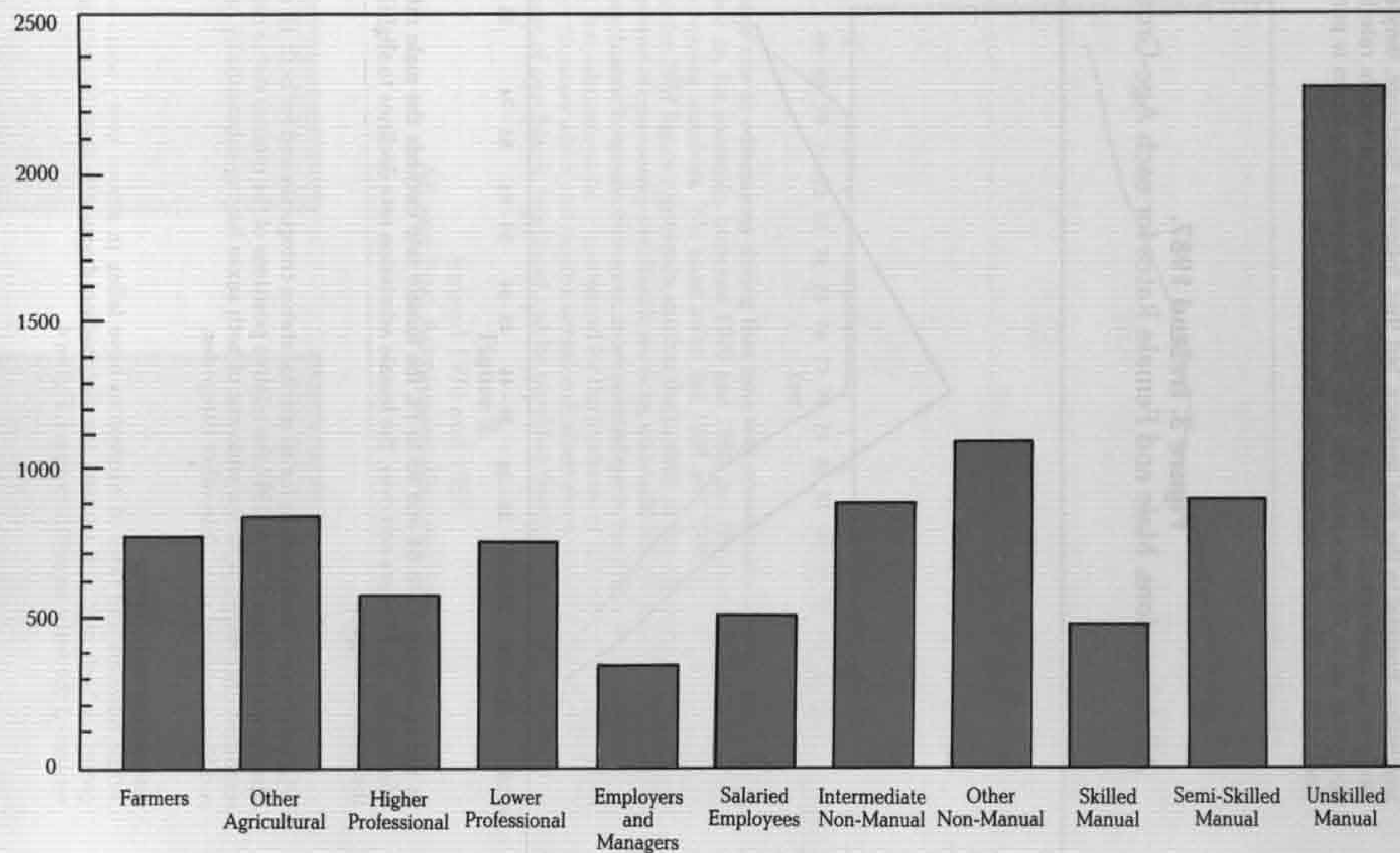
In the age-group 55 to 64 and 65 to 74, the female rate exceeds the male rate for all admissions. At 75 years and over, the female admission rate declines to slightly below the male rate again.

While numbers of admissions for all marital status categories and for both all and first admissions fell from 1986 to 1987 the relative positions of the marital status categories remained unchanged, with the widowed of both sexes having substantially higher all and first admission rates than other categories.

Socio-Economic Group

While numbers and rates of admissions have fallen in almost every socio-economic group for both men and women, the distribution among the socio-economic groups remained the same as previous years, Figure 4.

Rates per 100,000 Population.

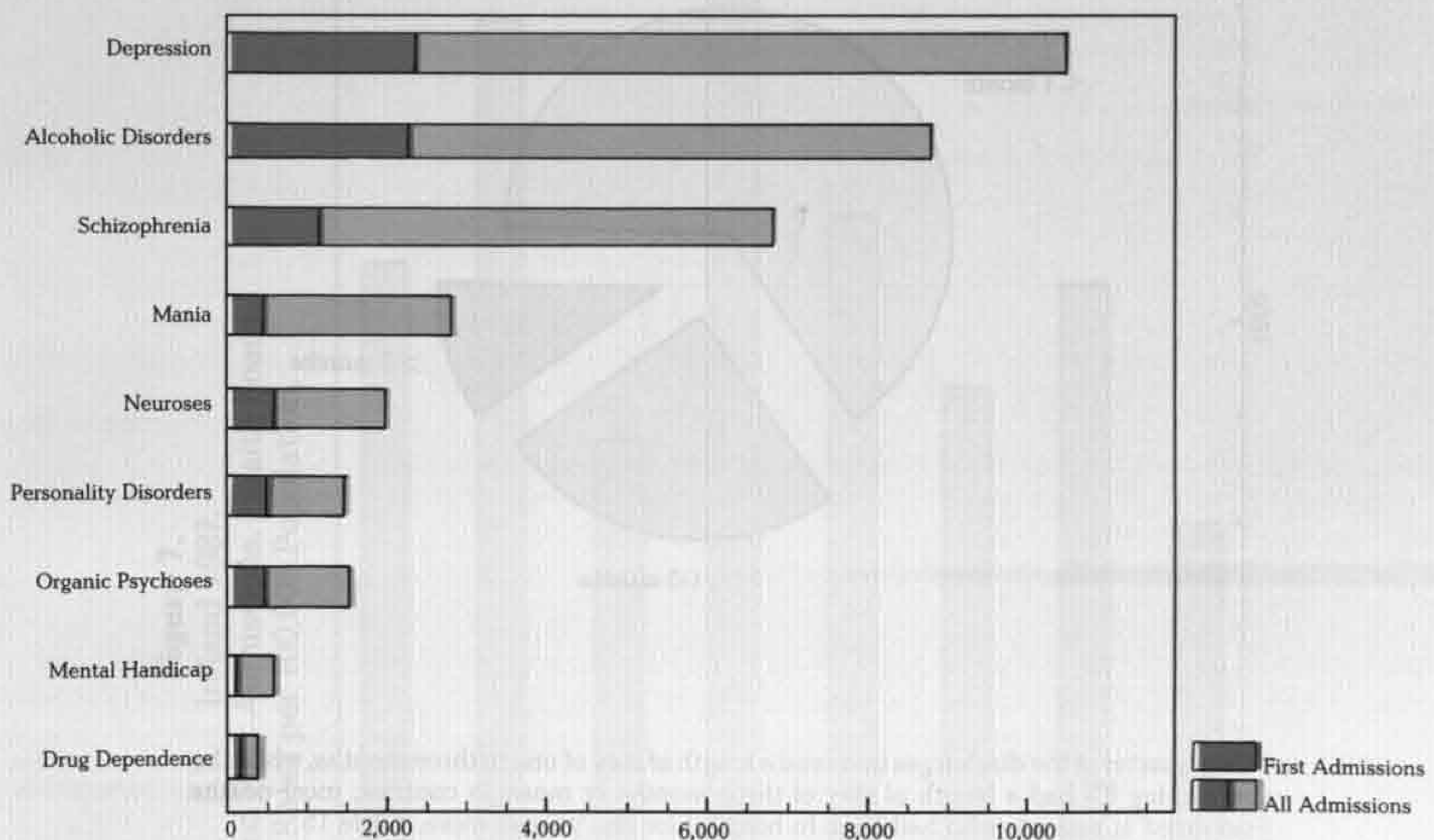


The highest admission rate is for the unskilled manual group and the lowest for employers and managers. The male rate exceeds the female rate in all but four socio-economic groups: farmers, employers and managers, salaried employees and other non-manual workers.

Diagnosis

As in previous years, the three main diagnostic groups were depressive disorders, alcohol disorders and schizophrenia, which together accounted for 73% of all admissions and 69% of first admissions in 1987.

The only diagnostic groups which showed slight increases over 1986 figures, were mania and neuroses. For men, alcohol disorders were the leading cause of admission, accounting for a third of all male admissions. For women, depression was the main cause of admission, accounting for 39% of all female admissions, and being twice as great as the next nearest diagnostic group for women, schizophrenia. As for all admissions, the first admission rate for schizophrenia was greater for males than females whereas admission rates for depressive disorders were greater for women than for men. On the other hand admission rates for alcohol disorders, both all and first, were substantially greater for men than women (Table 4).

Legal Status

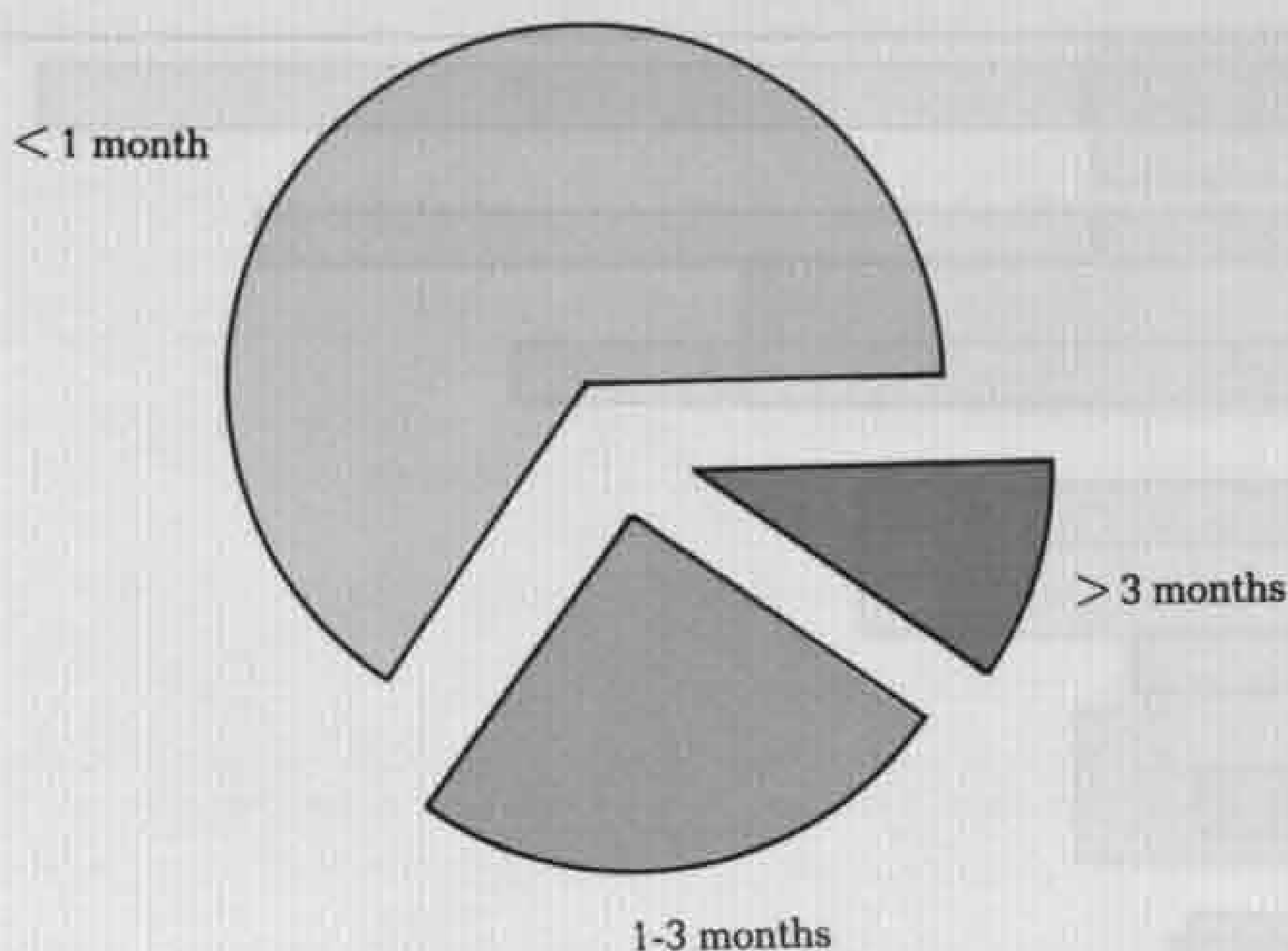
Of all patients admitted during 1987, 89% were voluntary compared with 88% in 1986.

Discharges and Deaths

There were 28,002 discharges, including deaths, from Irish psychiatric hospitals and units in 1987. This was a decrease on the 1986 figure of 29,409. Of the 28,002 discharges in 1987, 682 or 2% were deaths. Most of the deaths occurred in the 65 years and over age-groups.

Two-thirds of the discharges took place following a length of stay of under one month, Figure 6.

Percentages.

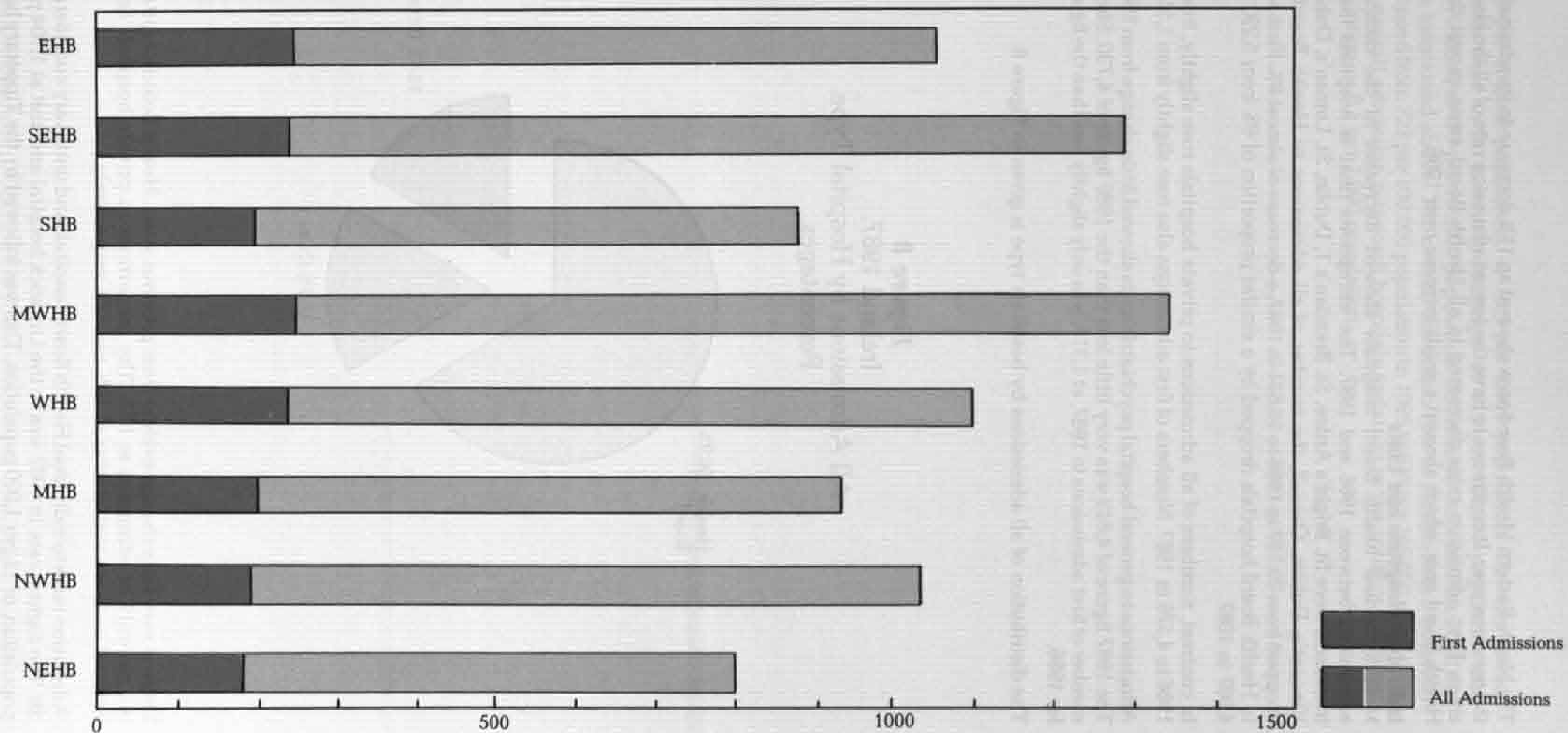


One quarter of the discharges involved a length of stay of one to three months, while the remaining 8% had a length of stay of three months or more. In contrast, most deaths occurred in patients who had been in hospital for one year or more, Table 15.

Health Board Areas

Admissions rates fell in every Health Board area during 1987, compared to 1986. The biggest decrease was in the Southern Health Board area where the all admission rate dropped by 14%. In 1986, the Southern Health Board area had the highest admission rate of all the Health Boards, but the drop in the 1987 admission rate brought it below the Mid-Western Health Board area, which had the highest admission rate in 1987, Figure 7.

The North-Eastern Health Board area showed an 11% decrease in its admission rate on the previous year. It continues to have the lowest admission rate of all the Health Board areas. First admission rates decreased in all Health Board areas except the Eastern Health Board area, which showed a small increase over 1986.

Individual Hospitals and Units

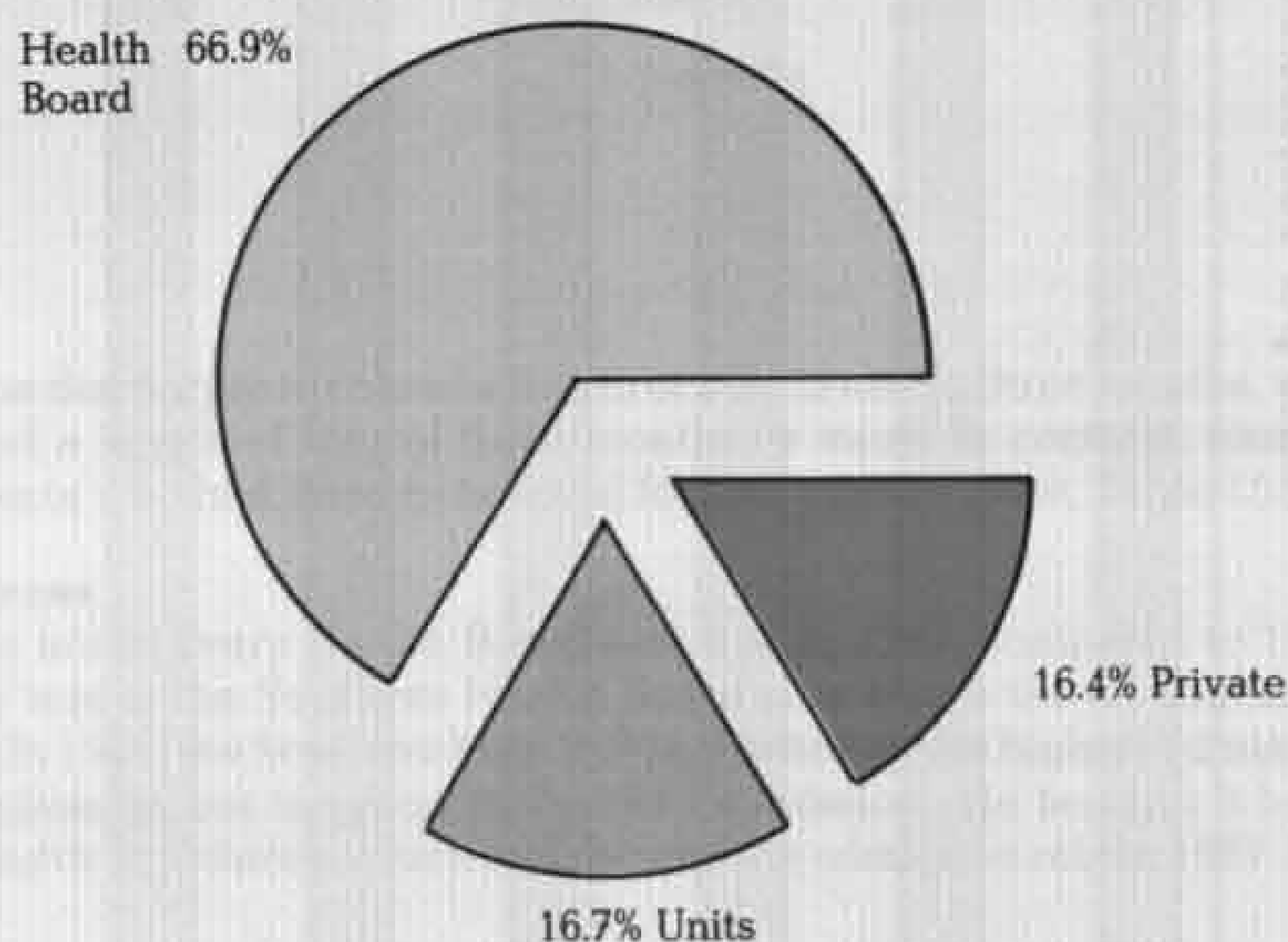
Most individual health board hospitals showed decreases in the numbers of all admissions between 1986 and 1987. The exceptions (that is hospitals that showed increases) were St. Brigid's Ardee, St. Brendan's 1, Dublin, St. Loman's, Dublin and St. Vincent's, Dublin. Overall, the number of all admissions to Health Board hospitals dropped from 20,157 in 1986 to 18,631 in 1987, a decrease of almost 8%. First admissions to Health Board hospitals dropped by a similar proportion of 6% from 5,292 in 1986 to 4,987 in 1987.

In contrast, numbers of all admissions to private hospitals rose slightly, from 4,505 in 1986 to 4,576 in 1987. Numbers of first admissions also rose slightly from 1,513 to 1,629.

Admissions to general hospital psychiatric units showed little change from 1986 to 1987. The 1987 figure of 4,649 was very little less than the 1986 figure of 4,730. Similarly, the number of first admissions in 1987, at 1,318, was only slightly less than the figure of 1,446 for 1986.

The distribution of all admissions by hospitals type is given in Figure 8.

There is very little change evident from previous years. Health Board hospitals receive the majority of admission at 67%. The proportions to private hospitals and general hospital units are very similar at 16% and 17% respectively.

Admission rates to individual Health Board hospitals and units vary considerably, Table 38. The highest rate in 1987 was to the Limerick hospital and unit at 1,104 per 100,000 population, or 11 per 1,000 population. This was followed by the Tipperary hospital and

unit at 1,048 per 100,000 population, or 10.5 per 1,000 population. The two lowest admission rates were to St. Loman's, Mullingar at 443 per 100,000 population and Newcastle, Wicklow, at 477 per 100,000 population. These rates were less than half the highest rates mentioned above. The overall admission rate to Health Board hospitals and units dropped from 723 per 100,000 population in 1986 to 676 per 100,000 population in 1987. The overall admission rate to all hospitals and units in the country is 809 per 100,000 population or 8.1 per 1,000 population.
