John Barrington reported from the Committee appointed on the 20th June last, that they had examined Mr. Jones' Bill & that they find that the articles specified in the Proposal have been executed agreeable to the proposal; but that several Works were done which were not contained in the proposal & for which it appeared to them, he had charged exorbitantly; — but in consideration of the advance in the Price of Labour, & ~~other~~ during the time of his executing the Contract, they are of Opinion, that as Compensation for the Loss thereby incurred, His Bill should be paid as now presented —

Res^d That the foregoing report be agreed to, & that Mr. Jones be credited for the amount of his two Bills viz. Some £921:15:24. & the other £409:16:24
