### Summary

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- The purpose of this re-inspection was to inspect the section 60 Mental Health Act 2001 rights of any patient in the approved centre where applicable and to ensure that each resident's general health needs were assessed not less than every six months.
- In the sample of clinical files examined by inspectors there was evidence of six-monthly physical examinations having been completed.
- Section 60 Mental Health Act 2001 did not apply.

## **OVERVIEW**

In 2012, the Inspectorate inspected this Approved Centre against all of the Mental Health Act 2001 (Approved Centres) Regulations 2006. Following this inspection the Inspectorate undertook a re-inspection of the approved centre.

## **DESCRIPTION**

There had been a reduction of three beds in the overall bed number of the approved centre since the inspection in June 2012. On the day of inspection there were 22 residents, all of whom were voluntary. The purpose of this re-inspection was to inspect the section 60 Mental Health Act 2001 rights of any patient in the approved centre where applicable and to ensure that each resident's general health needs were assessed not less than every six months.
