CONSULTANT MANPOWER AS AT 1ST JANUARY 1994

1. INTRODUCTORY COMMENTS

- 1.1. Up to this, the Comhairle's consultant manpower statistics outlined the position as at 1st May each year. In June 1993 the Collaborative Study Group representing the Department of Health, the Comhairle and the Postgraduate Board published a discussion document entitled Medical Manpower in Acute Hospitals. This incorporated consultant manpower statistics as at the end of 1992. In order to avoid confusion with two sets of statistics being published around the same time relating to different years, it was decided not to publish the normal statistics as at 1st May 1993 and to publish the Comhairle Consultant Manpower statistics on a calendar year basis from now on starting with this document.
- 1.2. This report sets out statistical information related to the consultant manpower situation in Ireland at the 1st January, 1994. The compilation of the consultant manpower statistics is an on-going process which involves regular up-dating and refinement of data. The up-dating of the manpower statistics involves recording alterations in the number of consultant posts stemming from the regulation of such appointments by the Comhairle. Refinement of data involves the incorporation of new information about consultants in practice which comes to the attention of the Comhairle. The overall objective is to provide, as far as possible, a comprehensive and accurate reflection of the consultant manpower scene on the 1st January of each year.
- 1.3. All the statistical information except for Table No. 13

refers to public sector consultant appointments only. Data relating to persons engaged solely in private practice is included in paragraph 13.1 under the heading of "specialists in private practice". The reliability and comprehensiveness of this data may not be as good as that for public sector appointments as the Comhairle's regulatory functions do not extend to the private hospitals.

- 1.4. During the year 1993, there was a net increase of 16 consultant posts to the overall establishment - a 1.5% rise on the position at the end of December 1992.

## 2. CURRENT CONSULTANT MANPOWER

- 2.1. The consultant establishment at 1st January, 1994 in the public sector was 1,186 comprising 1,065 consultants in practice, 62 vacant approved posts which are in the process of being filled on a permanent basis, 22 posts under consideration by the Comhairle or cleared for funding by the Department of Health and 37 posts which are known to be vacant but where neither an application has been submitted to Comhairle or a Department of Health financial clearance has been received by the Comhairle. Table No. 1 shows a summary of the consultant manpower by specialty.

5.

SPECIALISATION

5.1 The increase in the trend towards specialisation is being reflected in the staffing profile of the large hospitals, mainly in Dublin and to a lesser extent in Cork and Galway. Table Nos. 5 and 5A highlight the concentration of available specialist (as distinct from generalist) expertise in the Eastern area and also illustrates the paucity of specialist consultants elsewhere. National/semi-national specialsit units such as cardiac surgery, neurosurgery and organ transplantation are located

in Dublin and to a lesser extent in Cork.

9. **MALE/FEMALE BREAKDOWN OF PERMANENT CONSULTANTS**

9.1. Of the 1065 consultants in practice, 894 were male (83.86%) and 172 were female (16.14%). A breakdown of the position at 1st January 1994 by specialty is given in Table No. 9.

**DEATHS/RESIGNATIONS/RETIREMENTS**

10.1 Based on the number of consultants in practice, the death and resignation rate was 0.1% and 0.3% respectively while the retirement rate was 1.4%.

11.

**NEW CONSULTANTS**

11.1 The number of doctors identified as taking up duty for the first time in 1993 as permanent consultants in this country was 48 - the average over the previous three years being 52. 9(19%) of the new consultants are female. The percentage of new consultants who are female has varied a lot over recent years - from 25% in 1990 to 18% in 1991 to 44% in 1992. Table No. 11 sets out the position in detail.

**TEMPORARY/LOCUM POSTS**

12.1 It should be noted in relation to Table No. 1 and Table No. 2 that while posts are referred to as being vacant, under consideration or unprocessed, this does not necessarily mean that they are unoccupied - in most cases they are filled in a temporary or locum capacity pending the submission or processing of an application or the making of a permanent appointment through the usual selection procedures.

12.2 The information available to the Comhairle indicates that there were 100 temporary/locum appointments (including 14 retired consultants doing their own locum pending the making of permanent replacement appointments). The corresponding figure on 31st May 1992 was 134 (see Table No. 2 in the Fifth Report of the Comhairle) indicating an overall reduction of 25%. In the Comhairle's view, the latest figures are still unacceptably high. The Comhairle will continue in its efforts to address the variety of local circumstances which give rise to the continued existence of these appointments. A breakdown by specialty and health board area is given in Table No. 12.

**SPECIALISTS IN PRIVATE PRACTICE**

13.1 Information relating to specialists in private practice (i.e. who are not contracted to public hospitals) is presented in Table No. 13. Appointments in this category are not subject to regulation by the Comhairle or any other agency. While efforts have been made to ensure as much accuracy and comprehensiveness as possible in compiling this data, its reliability (particularly in relation to

those who have ceased to practice) is somewhat less than that relating to the public sector data. According to the information available, the number of specialists in private practice is 179. This data includes 15 consultants who have retired from public sector appointments and who continue to work in private hospitals.
