Statutory Agencies

REGIONAL DRUG CO-ORDINATION UNIT

The Drug Co-ordination Unit is a designated unit, responsible for the strategic planning and co-ordination of drug misuse initiatives in the South Eastern Health Board Region. The Unit provides information to the public on the services available in relation to drug and alcohol misuse and is also responsible for the collection of data in order to ascertain the true nature, extent and changing trends in drug related issues and to develop appropriate strategies in response.

LOCAL SUBSTANCE MISUSE TEAMS AND ADDICTION COUNSELLING SERVICES

Local Substance Misuse Teams were established in Waterford, Wexford, Tipperary S.R. and Carlow/Kilkenny in 2001. Four Substance Misuse Co-ordinators were appointed to lead these teams, which include Addiction Counsellors, Drug Education Officers and Community Based Drug Initiatives. The purpose of the Teams is to work closely with relevant statutory, community, voluntary groups and G.P.'s etc. in the provision of service, and to assess the need for the development of services/initiatives to combat drugs within each Community Care area.

Addiction Services are in operation in each Community Care area and offer counselling for all types of addictions, including alcohol, gambling and drugs etc. Counselling and support is offered to substance misusers and concerned family members or friends, on a low threshold easily accessible basis in a variety of locations - Day Centres, Health Centres, Youth Services/Community Care Buildings etc. The services include assessment, advice, information, individual counselling, group therapy, family support, out-patient and in-patient detoxification, maintenance programme, aftercare and education/prevention programmes. ***In order to obtain a clinic appointment, contact must be made with a counsellor to arrange an appointment.***

Referral is open referral, for example: self, Juvenile Liaison Officers, Psychologists, Probation and Welfare Services, Schools, FÁS, General Practitioners, Child and Adolescent Psychiatrists or Concerned Persons.

DRUG TREATMENT CLINIC - (METHADONE)

Drug Treatment Clinics are essentially for those addicted to Opiates.

1. If a person who is permanently resident in the South East i.e. a person who not only gives an address in the South East but also receives Social Welfare or is working in the South East, wishes to go on the Methadone Programme, he/she is referred to Dr. P. Troy (G.P. for Methadone Treatment, assigned to Drug Treatment Clinics) for assessment.
2. If it is decided that the person is to be placed on the methadone programme, Dr. Troy will arrange a pharmacy locally to supply the methadone and send the details to the Central Treatment List.
3. The Central Treatment List will issue a card with the persons photograph to the pharmacy.
4. The pharmacy will then dispense the Methadone.

If the person is already on the programme elsewhere and moves permanently to the South East:

5. The prescribing Doctor notifies the Central Treatment List or the Specialist for Public Health Medicine in the South Eastern Health Board and they arrange for a G.P. and pharmacy locally to treat this person.
6. If no Doctor is available in the area, the person is referred to Dr. Troy's clinic.
7. The Central Treatment List then transfers his/her card to the pharmacy in the South East.
8. If a person comes here on holidays from other parts of the country or from abroad, they need to have adequate supply of methadone as there is no emergency service available locally.

If emergency treatment is needed they should contact Trinity Court, 30/31 Pierce Street, Dublin 2 (tel: 01 6488600) and attend a clinic there.

The aim of these projects is to support the local communities in increasing their awareness for drug related issues and to help develop strategies to reduce the demand for drugs in the communities.

Aiséirí provides treatment for alcoholics, and other chemically dependent people. The residential programme lasts for 30 days and is followed by an aftercare programme of two years. Through their Family Support Programme, they also offer help and guidance to the spouses and relatives of addicts by offering Group Therapy and Family Support Programmes, which includes a five-day residential programme for family members and a relapse prevention programme.
