A. Executive Summary

Basis for report

The 39 ERHA agencies were sent a high level questionnaire in February 2001 (see Appendix 1) and where necessary received reminder telephone calls to submit responses. The objective of the questionnaire was to gather information and assess the level of euro preparation across the agencies. The information contained in this report is based on the replies received.

Key findings

The principal findings arising from the questionnaire are as follows:

- The level of progress and implementation differs considerably with some agencies only now starting to prepare for the euro, whilst others are well advanced.
- 29% have not set a date for conversion of base currency to euro or a date for conversion of payroll systems and staff payments to euro.
- Over 40% have not made an inventory of all systems that will require change.
- Several agencies have not communicated with their internal department leaders/supervisors to outline the impact of the euro.
- 42% of the agencies believe that outside help will be required as staff resources are not sufficient.
- Only 34 % have carried out a training needs assessment.
- Agencies (listed in Appendix 2) have contacted us to provide individual support.

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

C. Summary of findings

- We received 38 completed questionnaires i.e. all ERHA agencies with the exception of Temple St. Children's Hospital.
- 29 of the 38 replies stated that euro plans had advanced since October 2000.
- However the majority of those that had not advanced plans, had carried out considerable preparation prior to October 2000.
- 11 of the 38 agencies have not set a date for conversion of base currency. We had anticipated that all
 agencies would have dates set at this stage.
- 9 of the 38 replies (24%) have not communicated the impact of the euro to relevant staff. In order to
 ensure a smooth transition to the euro, staff must be made aware of the effects and be involved in the
 changeover process.
- 2 agencies have not contacted IT suppliers to discuss the required changes. This is important due to lead times and testing.
- 13 of the 38 replies have not yet put procedures in place for handling both currencies. Although the
 agencies may not yet have received a euro invoice, for example, procedures should be agreed and relayed
 to staff prior to changeover.
- Only 9 agencies have reported an increase in the number of euro invoices to date.
- Only 34% of replies stated that a euro training needs assessment has been carried out. Communication
 and training is fundamental to a successful changeover and a detailed training plan with a clear timeframe
 for delivery should be a priority for all agencies.
- Only 13 agencies have taken a decision on the conversion of historical data. Some agencies were unaware that historical data would need to be converted.
- 10 of 38 replies have not set a conversion date for payroll systems or payroll payments.
- 42% of the agencies have not yet carried out an inventory of systems, forms etc. that will require change, yet a number of these have contacted already IT suppliers. This should be addressed immediately to ensure that all systems/procedures are covered by the IT suppliers.
- 16 of the 38 replies believe that outside help will be required as staff resources are not sufficient;
- 8 agencies are concerned about resources for testing, and overtime demands on staff.
- Only 7 of the replies stated that they have euro bank accounts. It would be advisable for agencies to discuss changeover plans with banks at an early stage.
- All 38 replies stated that either they were not making euro payments so could not specify the difficulties in making them, or had not experienced difficulties in making prompt euro payments.






Have plans for the euro advanced since October 2000?

Has the date for the conversion of base currency to euro been set?











Has the impact of the euro been communicated to team leaders?

Have you outlined your IT requirements to your IT suppliers?










Have you procedures for handing IR£ and euro?






Have you decided on a conversion date of payroll?




Have you made an inventory of all systems etc which need to be converted to euro?




Do you have sufficient staff resources in house to manage conversion?
