- Special Board Meeting At a recent meeting of the Protocol Committee, it was agreed that a Special Board Meeting be held on Friday 28th March at 11.30 a.m. to discuss Mental Health.

The Chairman invited Dr Laffoy, Director of Public Health to give an update on the current situation with regard to the Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS). She advised the meeting that this is relevant only to people who have been in the affected areas i.e. Hong Kong, Vietnam, Singapore and Guandong Province in China and to seek medical advice should they become unwell during their trip or within 10 days of returning home. She further advised that an expert group has been established by the Minister for Health & Children to monitor the situation and is currently working with airports, hospitals and health experts. She also updated the meeting on the status of reported cases in the region.

The Regional Chief Executive advised the meeting that the cause for SARS has not yet been identified but is being examined internationally.

- Mr Woods advised that the Authority submits the budget estimates to the Department of Health & Children in June each year along with additional information and it is an ongoing process.
- He said a budget comparison for the Authority and Agencies for 2001 & 2002 had been submitted to the Finance and Property Committee.

Mr Lyons advised that he would present an update to the Board at a future date on the Treatment Purchase Fund and Waiting List Initiative. He also said he would make a presentation to the Finance and Property and Protocol Committees following the publication of the Commission of Financial Management & Procedures, Medical Manpower Study and Audit of Structures Reports.
