Director of Flexible Training

The Board employs a part-time Director of Flexible Training – Dr. W.P. Blunnie. The purpose of the appointment is to promote and co-ordinate a pilot scheme for flexible (i.e. part-time) training for non consultant hospital doctors. [In its initial phase the scope of the scheme is confined to higher specialist training, but may be extended later to general professional training].

Co-ordinator of Vocational Training in Dentistry

The Board employs a part-time Co-ordinator of Vocational Training in Dentistry – Dr. F. Ormsby. The purpose of this appointment is to promote co-ordinated training of a high standard for dentists undergoing vocational training.

Co-ordinator and Course Organisers, Regional Dental Committees.

The Board's Eastern Regional Dental Committee employs a part-time Co-ordinator and each of the Board's other Regional Dental Committees employs a part-time Course Organiser whose general duties are to promote and encourage continuing dental education at individual, group and regional level, to liaise with all groups interested in such education, to make recommendations to the regional committee on local needs, to provide continuing dental education as appropriate and to be involved in the assessment of the relevance and effectiveness of different courses and activities organised within the functional area of the regional committee. National Directorate, General Practitioner Continuing Education Programmes

During 2006 the Board funded the appointments under the auspices of the Irish College of General Practitioners of Dr. H. Finnegan, Ballinasloe and Dr. C. McNicholas, Dublin as National Director and Assistant National Director of Continuing Education Schemes respectively. Their role was to co-ordinate and encourage the development of the activities of the Tutors of those schemes and to establish and maintain a bank of educational resources for use by small groups.

Tutors, General Practitioner Continuing Education Programmes

Each of the General Practitioner Continuing Education Programmes funded by the Board employs a part-time Tutor. The general duties of the Tutors are to promote, encourage and co-ordinate continuing education for the general practitioners in their areas both at an individual level and principally by promoting and encouraging the formation of small groups which should meet regularly in an informal atmosphere with the emphasis being on participation and discussion rather than didactic teaching. The Tutors provide guidance and resources for such small groups, seek to co-ordinate and integrate their programmes with other continuing medical education activities and seek to ensure that the principles of assessing needs, defining objectives, active problem-based learning and performance review apply. Outline of Board's Activities

The main activities undertaken by the Board, or under its aegis, in 2006 could be summarised as follows:-

- agreed to a request from the Minister for Health and Children that the Board provide appropriate assistance, advice and expertise to the Health Service Executive in order to facilitate the streamlining of the Board's functions and the future development of postgraduate medical and dental education and training.
- met with the Department of Health and Children, the HSE and the Medical and Dental Councils and with the Irish Joint Committee of Postgraduate Training Bodies to seek as much common ground as possible on a future vision for postgraduate medical and dental training and to agree to how the Board can most effectively perform its role in conjunction with those bodies,
- wrote to the Training Bodies drawing their attention to the Lourdes Hospital Inquiry Report and advising them to consider and take notice of the comments/recommendations relating to hospital inspections/accreditation and to audit as it applies to training,
- conveyed views to the Department of Health and Children on the proposed Medical Practitioners Bill,
- adopted the following documents which had been prepared by the Board's Finance and Audit Committee in the context of the Code of Practice for Governance of State Bodies -
 - o Role and Functions of Board Members

- o Code of Business Conduct for members of the PgMDB
 - o Roles and Responsibilities of the Chairman
 - o Role and Functions of the Chief Officer
 - o Code of Business Conduct for Staff Members
- recognised for the Board's purposes under the Medical Practitioners Act, 1978 the Faculty of Sports and Exercise Medicine, RCPI and RCSI,
 - agreed that it should seek to have discussions with the HSE-EA relating to aspects of the Protection of Employees (Fixed-Term Work) Act, 2003 in the context of NCHD contracts; also brought the issue to the attention of the Medical Council,
 - conducted a survey of NCHD Staffing at 1 October, 2006,
 - continued to develop the Board's career guidance programme for young doctors,
 - organised Medical Careers Fairs in Cork and Galway for interns and first year house officers and to which medical students were also admitted; these fairs attracted overall attendances of about 150,
 - arranged in conjunction with the ICGP and with funding from the HSE – METR a national medical careers seminar. The seminar incorporated all the usual features of the Board's Careers Fairs and also included workshops on CV presentation and interview preparation and performance and attracted an attendance of about 110.
 - made career guidance material readily available and accessible by placing it on the Board's website,
 - continued to fund, in partnership with the HSE, regional dental committees in the East, Midlands, North-East, North-West, South/Mid-West, South-East and in the West; the main function of the last six named regional committees is to promote continuing dental education (CDE) within their respective areas, with the Eastern Regional Dental Committee being principally concerned with the co-ordination of CDE in its area,
 - organised a Continuing Dental Education accreditation system [at 31 December, 2006 over 1,490 dentists were participating therein],
 - employed a Co-ordinator for the Vocational Training Scheme in Dentistry whose role concerns the promotion of co-ordinated vocational training of a high standard,
 - funded the appointment of the Director of Specialist Training in Dentistry employed by Irish Committee for Specialist Training in Dentistry,
 - organised a Pilot Scheme on Flexible (Part-time) Training for Senior, Specialist and G.P. Registrars and appointed a Sub-Committee to look at the existing flexible training scheme,

to assess and comment on its strengths and weaknesses and to make recommendations for the future,

- employed a Director for the Pilot Scheme on Flexible Training,
- continued to administer a scheme whereby NCHDs are reimbursed the fees paid by them in respect of specified postgraduate examinations and courses,
- provided an administrative service for the Irish Psychiatric Training Committee and provided funds to that Committee to enable it to administer its national higher training scheme,
- funded the development and organisation of higher specialist training schemes in anaesthetics, pathology, paediatrics, medicine, occupational medicine, radiology and surgery,
- the Board's Chief Officer is a member of the National Implementation Group on the European Working Time Directive,
- funded thirty-seven general practitioner continuing education programmes/schemes (GPCME schemes) - based in Bray, Carlow/Kilkenny, Cavan/Monaghan, Clare, Cork [East, North, West, Cork City (3 schemes)], Donegal (2 schemes), Dublin [ICGP Faculty areas: Corrigan, Dublin South-West, Dun Laoghaire, Merrion, North Dublin, West Dublin, William Stokes/Mount Carmel (2 schemes)], East Midlands, Galway (2 schemes), Kerry (2 schemes), Kildare, Laois/Offaly, Limerick, Louth/Meath, Mayo (2 schemes), Sligo/Leitrim, Tipperary (2 schemes), Waterford, West Midlands and Wexford,
- continued to fund the appointments of a National Director and of an Assistant National Director of continuing education schemes, under the auspices of the Irish College of General Practitioners, to co-ordinate and encourage the development of the activities of the Tutors of such schemes, and to establish and maintain a bank of educational resources for use by small groups,
- facilitated the strategic management of the ICGP's General Practice Postgraduate Resource Centre and helped to fund that Centre,
- the Board's Chief Officer is a member of the Steering Committees of the Eastern Regional, Midland, Mid-Western, North-Eastern, South Eastern and Western Training Programmes in General Practice,
- conducted, in association with the ICGP, a national matching scheme for the July, 2006 trainee intake to the Vocational Training Programmes in General Practice. The matching scheme was operated by the Board on behalf of the eleven Vocational Training Programmes and the National Association of Programme Directors,
- provided financial assistance to the RCSI to help in the funding of the Diploma Course in Management for Medical Doctors which is organised under the aegis of the RCSI and the Institute of Public Administration,

- provided financial support to the UCD-based Diploma Course in Healthcare Risk Management,
- provided financial assistance to the organization of a seminar on "Building capacity in Irish General Practice Education",
- contributed towards funding the costs levied on the RCPI in respect of its membership of the Academy of Medical Royal Colleges (in Ireland and in the UK),
- the Budget adopted by the Board in 2006 included the commitment of the following full year costs in respect of the new developments outlined beneath –
 - €120K for the RCSI in respect of the (i) operating costs of its Mobile Skills Unit and (ii) funding the secretarial costs of the Institute of Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgery,
 - €164K to enable the IPTC to fund (i) a Project Director (with administrative support) and (ii) an Academic and Research Organiser,
 - €104K to enable 4 extra GPCME Tutors to be appointed.
- provided financial assistance to the postgraduate training bodies in their exercise, as national bodies, of a general control over programmed training - Details are provided in the Accounts. The Bodies so assisted comprised those listed at (i) to (xi) on page 9 (with the exception of the Faculty of Sports and Exercise Medicine together with the Faculties of (a) Public Health Medicine, (b) Occupational Medicine and (c) Paediatrics - the last three named bodies are Faculties within the Royal College of Physicians of Ireland,
- decided it should seek to establish principles as to how best to fund the training bodies in the future and how best to evaluate the effectiveness of that funding.

Among the main activities undertaken by the Co-ordinators of Postgraduate Medical Education during 2006 were:-

(a) the organisation of

 - # computer courses for doctors,
- (b) provision of advice to hospitals regarding library facilities,
 - (c) helped the Board in the organisation of the career guidance programme for interns and house officers,
 - (d) participated in the consultative groups associated with the GPCME schemes,
 - (e) preparation and circulation of weekly, fortnightly or monthly "postgraduate conference and meeting diaries",
 - (f) participated in the management and administration of postgraduate centres and in the organisation of the programmes of activities in such centres.

- The Irish Psychiatric Training Committee;
- The Irish Surgical Postgraduate Training Committee;
- A Committee of the Royal College of Physicians of Ireland, which deals with general professional training in Medicine.

Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December, 2006

Statement of Responsibilities of the Board

The term of office of the Postgraduate Medical and Dental Board expired on 26 March, 2002. In light of the proposed reorganisation of the Health Services the Board was not then re-appointed. A new Board was appointed by the Minister for Health and Children in January, 2006 for a period of five years.

The Medical Practitioners Act, 1978, requires the Board to keep proper accounts of all income and expenditure of the Board and of the sources of such income and the subject matter of such expenditure and all proper accounts of property, assets and liabilities of the Board. In preparing the financial statements, the Board is required to

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently
- make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent
- prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the Board will continue in operation.
- state whether applicable accounting standards have been followed, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the financial statements.

The Board is responsible for keeping proper books of account which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Board and which enable it to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Medical Practitioners Act, 1978. The Board is also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Board and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities. In the absence of Board members the Accounting Officer of the Department of Health and Children (DoHC) and the Chief Officer of the Board signed the Financial Statements on behalf of the Board. This arrangement was an interim one pending the appointment of a new Board and covered the years 2002, 2003 and 2004. In January, 2006 a new Board was appointed by the Minister for Health and Children which resulted in the reversion of current responsibilities for accountability from the Accounting Officer of the DoHC to the appointed Board.

Statement on Internal Financial Control

Responsibility for the System of Internal Financial Control

On behalf of the Board of the Postgraduate Medical and Dental Board, I acknowledge the Board's responsibility for ensuring that an effective system of internal financial control is maintained and operated.

In March 2002 the term of office of the Board Members expired. In light of the proposed reorganisation of the Health Services the Board was not re-appointed. In the absence of the appointment of a new Board, the Accounting Officer of the Department of Health and Children and the Chief Officer of the Board signed the Financial Statements as an interim measure.

In January, 2006 a new Board was appointed which resulted in the reversion of current responsibilities for accountability from the Accounting Officer of the Department of Health and Children to the appointed Board.

The system of internal control can only provide reasonable but not absolute assurance that assets are safeguarded, transactions authorised and properly recorded, and that material errors or irregularities are either prevented or would be detected in a timely period.

Key Control Procedures

At its first meeting in January 2006, the new Board appointed a Finance and Audit Committee that was given the task of investigating the need for a review of existing internal control procedures.

The existing system of internal financial control is based on regular review by the Chief Officer of the operation of the Board's accounts and of its accounting procedures.

The Board is informed by and will seek input from the Chief Officer who has responsibility for the development and maintenance of an appropriate financial control framework. The Board will also rely upon reports and comments made by the Finance and Audit Committee and by the Comptroller and Auditor General in his management letters or other reports.

Annual Review of Controls

The Board did not carry out a review of the effectiveness of internal controls in 2006. It is the intention of the Audit and Finance Committee to conduct the review of the internal controls before the end of 2007.

Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December, 2006

Accounting Policies

1 General

The Postgraduate Medical and Dental Board was established in March, 1980 as a statutory body under the Medical Practitioners Act, 1978. Its function is to promote the development of postgraduate medical and dental education.

The functions of the Board are under review by the Minister for Health and Children as part of the health strategy to reorganise and consolidate the health care structure. It is proposed, following the audit of the structures and functions of the health system to merge the functions of the Postgraduate Medical and Dental Board between the Health Services Executive and the Medical Council and the Dental Council. The Minister, pending the approval of legislation to give effect to the above changes appointed a new Board in January 2006.

2 Basis of Preparation

The Financial Statements are prepared in accordance with accounting policies laid down by the Minister for Health and Children under the historical cost convention. Subject to Accounting Policy 6 below, financial reporting standards recommended by the recognised accountancy bodies are adopted as they become operative.

3 Income

- (a) Oireachtas grants are accounted for on a cash receipts basis.
- (b) Grants for "once-off" Medical Education and Training Projects (MET)

Grants for special projects funded by the Department of Health and Children are included in the period in which the related expenditure is incurred.

4 Fixed Assets and Depreciation

Fixed assets are shown at cost or valuation less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation is calculated on a straight line basis at 10% for furniture and fittings and 20% for office equipment.

5 Capital Account

The Capital Account represents the unamortised value of grants applied for capital purposes.

6 Superannuation

Section 19 of the Medical Practitioners Act, 1978 applies the terms of the Local Government (Superannuation) Act, 1956 to the Board and its officers, subject to any modifications which may, with the consent of the Minister for the Environment and Local Government, be determined by the Minister for Health and Children.

The Board operates a defined benefit superannuation scheme for its employees. Superannuation entitlements arising under the scheme are paid out of current income and are charged to the Income and Expenditure Account in the year in which they become payable. In accordance with a direction of the Minister for Health and Children, no provision is made in the financial statements in respect of future benefits. Salaries and Wages are charged in the financial statements net of employee superannuation contributions.

Report of the Comptroller and Auditor General for presentation to the Houses of the Oireachtas

I have audited the financial statements of the Postgraduate Medical and Dental Board for the year ended 31 December 2005 under Section 5 of the Comptroller and Auditor General (Amendment) Act, 1993.

The financial statements, which have been prepared under the accounting policies set out therein, comprise the Accounting Policies, the Income and Expenditure Account, the Balance Sheet and the related notes.

Respective Responsibilities of the Board and the Comptroller and Auditor General

The Postgraduate Medical and Dental Board is responsible for preparing the financial statements and for ensuring the regularity of transactions. The Board prepares the financial statements in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Practice in Ireland as modified by the directions of the Minister for Health and Children in relation to accounting for superannuation costs. The accounting responsibilities of the Members of the Board are set out in the Statement of Board Members' Responsibilities.

My responsibility is to audit the financial statements in accordance with relevant legal and regulatory requirements and International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland).

I report my opinion as to whether the financial statements give a true and fair view, in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Practice in Ireland. I also report whether in my opinion proper books of account have been kept. In addition, I state whether the financial statements are in agreement with the books of account.

I report any material instance where moneys have not been applied for the purposes intended or where the transactions do not conform to the authorities governing them.

I also report if I have not obtained all the information and explanations necessary for the purposes of my audit.

I review whether the Statement on Internal Financial Control reflects the Board's compliance with the Code of Practice for the Governance of State Bodies and report any material instance where it does not do so, or if the statement is misleading or inconsistent with other information of which I am aware from my audit of the financial statements. I am not required to consider whether the Statement on Internal Financial Control covers all financial risks and controls, or to form an opinion on the effectiveness of the risk and control procedures.

I read other information contained in the Annual Report, and consider whether it is consistent with the audited financial statements. I consider the implications for my report if I become aware of any apparent misstatements or material inconsistencies with the financial statements.

Basis of Audit Opinion

In the exercise of my function as Comptroller and Auditor General, I conducted my audit of the financial statements in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland) issued by the Auditing Practices Board and by reference to the special considerations which attach to State bodies in relation to their management and operation. An audit includes examination, on a test basis, of evidence relevant to the amounts and disclosures and regularity of the financial transactions included in the financial statements. It also includes an assessment of the significant estimates and judgments made

in the preparation of the financial statements, and of whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Board's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

I planned and performed my audit so as to obtain all the information and explanations that I considered necessary in order to provide me with sufficient evidence to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or other irregularity or error. In forming my opinion I also evaluated the overall adequacy of the presentation of information in the financial statements.

Opinion

As explained in Accounting Policy 6, the Board recognises the costs of superannuation entitlements only as they become payable. This policy does not comply with Financial Reporting Standard 17 which requires such costs to be recognised in the year the entitlements are earned. While non-compliance with Financial Reporting Standard 17 does not impact on the overall financial performance or position of the Board as disclosed in the financial statements, in my opinion compliance is necessary for a proper understanding of the costs of providing the superannuation benefits earned by employees during the year and of the value of the benefits that the Board has committed to providing in respect of service up to the year end.

Except for the failure to recognise the Board's superannuation costs and liabilities in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 17, the financial statements give a true and fair view, in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in Ireland, of the state of the Board's affairs at 31 December 2005 and of its income and expenditure for the year then ended.

In my opinion, proper books of account have been kept by the Board. The financial statements are in agreement with the books of account.
